Resolution 1

Resolution 8

ISO/TMB/WG SR requests the ISO/TMB to encourage NSBs to maintain committees of experts at the national level based on the recommended multi stakeholder composition and balance, for post publication activities of ISO 26000.

Resolution 9

ISO/TMB/WG SR requests ISO/TMB to establish a post publication organization for ISO 26000 with proposed terms of reference and composition as described in document WG SR N 192 rev 1.

Resolution 10

ISO/TMB/WG SR encourages each current stakeholder group of WG SR (Consumer, Government, Industry, Labour, NGO, SSRO) and language task forces to maintain its self-organized structure and functions through the first revision of ISO 26000. This is to provide for two-way communication with representatives on the proposed Post Publication Organization (Resolution 9), and to preserve and build on the strengths of existing stakeholder group networks, in order to contribute more effectively to the Post Publication Organization.
